## Illegal Dumping Alert



Recent home sales along with owners renovating their units, has generated an inordinate amount of construction debris. Recently, there have been several instances of illegal dumping in our dumpster. Our dumpster is designed for household trash only. Illegal items include construction materials, and furniture or appliances -- such as couches, TVs, tables, chairs, bookshelves, etc.

Every time someone leaves these items in our dumpster, the Association has to pay the city to collect them. This adds to the cost of our expenditures, which eventually increases our HOA fees. Please **DO NOT** place any of these items at the dumpster, or anywhere else on the property. Violators will be fined.

**TRASH REMINDER** -- As a friendly reminder, it is the owner's responsibility to properly dispose of their trash. Recently, the landscaping crew picked up several bags of trash throughout the grounds. Be aware that we are paying them to maintain the grounds and it costs us extra when they have to pick up trash before they can do their work. Residents can help by:

- Putting junk mail in trash cans located at the mailbox area
- Not discarding cigarette butts on the grounds
- Not putting trash in the breezeway outside your front door

**RECYCLABLES** -- The recycling containers are only for items such as newspapers, cans, glass and plastic. Please note the signage on the containers for appropriate dispensing and do not place regular household trash in these containers.

## Roswell: Best Place to Live

## Community Reminders



**Frozen Pipes** -- It's been a very cold winter already. Owners are reminded to make sure they protect and avoid any frozen pipes when the weather gets frigid.

We ask that you make sure your heat is maintained in all units including vacant and unoccupied units with the thermostats set no lower than 60 degrees. Additionally, when the temperature falls below 32, water is to be dripped to prevent pipes from freezing. Buildings with water heaters in the breezeway (200, 300, 500 & 1000) should also drip the hot water faucets. It is also recommended that you open cabinet doors under the sinks to help keep the pipes warm.

Please also keep in mind if you fail to protect your unit from freezing pipes and there is damage caused by a busted pipe, you could be held responsible for damages to other units besides your own.
